The light streaming through the wooden roof on a sunny day wasn't a good omen. After 25 years, the cedar shingles of the Lund-Hoel house needed attention. From the outside, the damage was not always noticeable; but from the inside, the buckets in the attic on a rainy day were a very good indication a major problem existed.

After close examination and discussion of the deteriorating roofs of the Lund-Hoel house and Carriage house, the board voted to replace both roofs in Spring, 2005. The maintenance committee developed a bid request form. Forms were distributed to all area lumber suppliers and the bid was advertised in the Canby News. Bids were opened and awarded on November 2, 2004. Terry Gackstetter of Lake

Benton was awarded the labor contract. Canby Builders was awarded the materials contract. Project is to be completed by July 1, 2005.

## Save Our History Grant Update

Last fall, the History Channel offered a Save Our History grant opportunity that would involve youth and historical groups in a project that would preserve and share local heritage.

MECCA enthusiastically and creatively prepared an application for a Military History Center to be located in the Interpretive Center. Ours was one of 699 applications requesting over \$5.6 million in funds. In the determination letter, it said "Despite the strength of your application, unfortunately, your organization did not receive one of the 29 grants

awarded this year." They congratulated us for our efforts in preserving our heritage and engaging our local community in their local history.

We are so convinced of the timely patriotic value of our project plan to our community and youth that we WILL RESUBMIT. Plans are to pursue the project in the future with coordination with the school media classes when funds are available.
